

Serenity's Love Project

Miss Daelyn was one of our core teachers and taught our preschool classes for many years. She has since moved on to finish beauty school, but one of the projects she desperately wanted to start was the Love Project. The Love Project would offer free performing arts classes to students in need whose family may not have the extra resources to pay for extracurricular activities.

Serenity will take one student per level each year. Those levels are:

1. Wee
2. Tiny
3. Level 1
4. Level 2
5. Level 3
6. Adult

Classes offered are:

- Vocal
- Dance Combo Classes
- Hip Hop
- Liturgical Program
- Theater Classes
- Tumbling

To qualify:

- the student must register for class as usual
- student must provide a recommendation letter from someone in their church or school who will vouch for the hardship, 3 times a year (fall registration, spring registration, and summer registration)
- student's family must agree to actively participate in all our fundraising activities throughout the year
- Money raised in fundraising will be applied to student's account to cover expenses such as shoes, bags, leo's, costumes, pictures and show fees
- Re-apply every year

Serenity will:

- Provide classes to student free of charge
- Provide a leo, tights, tap and ballet shoes free of charge
- Provide costumes for shows (some restrictions may apply)
- Apply fundraising money to any expenses student may need throughout the year
- Keep status of their hardship confidential from teachers and other students (admin must be made aware of hardship so they can update account information)

Dismissal from the program can result from:

- Lack of or refusal of fundraising program.

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- Social media postings or confidential information provided to us that indicate there is no hardship.
- Hardship is no longer an issue due to family finances improving
